

Terms of Service

The following terms of use ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the services of Channely website ("the Service"), and any information, text, graphics, or other materials uploaded, downloaded or appearing on the Services (collectively referred to as "Content"). Your access to and use of the Service is conditioned on your acceptance of and compliance with these Terms. By accessing or using the Service you agree to be bound by these Terms.

This Terms may be amended, modified, replaced in any form and at any time at the discretion of the Administration. After making significant changes / additions to the Agreement, all registered users will be notified about this through special notifications in the service 7 (Seven) days before the relevant changes / additions come into force.

The user must regularly check the latest version of the Terms on his own, learn himself with all changes and additions to the Service.

Please read these Terms carefully before accessing or using the Website. By accessing or using any part of the web site, you agree to become bound by the terms and conditions of this agreement. If you do not agree to all the terms and conditions of this agreement, then you may not access the Website or use any services. If these terms and conditions are considered an offer by Channely, acceptance is expressly limited to these terms. The Website is available only to individuals who are at least 13 years old.

1. Access to your Channely Account

You are responsible for your use of the Services, for any content you post to the [Telegram messenger channels](#) connected with Channely, and for any consequences thereof. The Content you submit, post, or display will be able to be viewed by other users of the Telegram messenger. You should only

provide Content that you are comfortable sharing with others under these Terms.

Channely may change, suspend or discontinue the Services at any time, including the availability of any feature, database, or content without prior notice to you.. Channely may also impose limits on certain features and services or restrict User's access to parts or all of the Services without notice or liability.

User certifies to Channely that if User is an individual (i.e., not a corporation) User is at least 13 years of age. User also certifies that it is legally permitted to use the Service, and takes full responsibility for the selection and use of the Service.

User shall be responsible for obtaining and maintaining any equipment or ancillary services needed to connect to, access the Service, including, without limitation, modems, hardware, software, and long distance or local telephone service. User shall be responsible for ensuring that such equipment or ancillary services are compatible with the Service.

2. Privacy

Your information, whether public or private, will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or given to any other company for any reason whatsoever, without your consent.

The email address you provide for registering may be used to send you information about recent updates, occasional company news, related product or service information, etc. Note: If at any time you would like to unsubscribe from receiving future emails, we include detailed unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email.

When do we collect information?

We collect information from you when you register on our site or enter information on our site.

How do we use your information?

We may use the information we collect from you when you register, make a purchase, sign up for our newsletter, respond to a survey or marketing communication, surf the website, or use certain other site features to personalize user's experience and to allow us to deliver the type of content and product offerings in which you are most interested.

Do we use 'cookies'?

Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the sites or service providers systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information.

We use cookies to understand and save your preferences for future visits.
